**F**rederick P. Haugen, MD (1908-1987) graduated from the University of Oregon Medical School in 1935 and completed a residency in anesthesiology at Bellevue Hospital in New York City under the mentorship of Dr. Emery A. Rovenstein. Dr. Haugen was Chief of the Anesthesiology Service at Presbyterian Hospital in Philadelphia for 10 years before returning to the University of Oregon Medical School in 1948 where he served as Chief of the Division of Anesthesiology until he retired in 1970. At the time of his retirement, Dr. Haugen secured departmental status for Anesthesiology.

Dr. Haugen was a member of the Board of Directors of the American Board of Anesthesiology (1949-1962) and also served as board president (1959-1960). In 1968, he received the Distinguished Service Award from the American Society of Anesthesiologists. The Oregon Society of Anesthesiologists established the Haugen Lectureship in 1987 to bring noted anesthesiologists to Portland “to advance the art and science of anesthesiology.”
